



Access

The Château de Losse is situated 5km from Montignac near the D706 road towards Eyzies.

Particularities

- * It is starred in the Michelin Guide Vert Périgord-Quercy.
- * It is a visitable castle with gardens that have been labeled "remarkable garden" in 2004.
- * It has been classified as a "Historical Monument" since 1928 and a natural site since 1944.
- * Labeled Tourism and Handicap (auditory and mental).

Historical

The family of Losse, originally from Flanders, built a stronghold on the bank of the Vézère in the 11th century. Jean II de Losse (1504-1580) is at the origin of a major modification of the building in order to ensure its protection. The castle has remained unchanged since the 16th century.

The castle

A chatelet defends the courtyard of the castle and the drawbridge of which only traces remain. On the outside, there are ditches, initially filled with water, which were another effective means of defense.

Three towers surround the building:

- * The Sainte-Marguerite tower (transformed into a pigeon loft),
- * The tower of Eperon,
- * The tower of the North-East on the Vézère.

Visit

The castle is visitable part of the year (6 months), and its gardens, as well as numerous "attractions" (distractions) are provided for the youngest and the visit is accessible in several languages thanks to a translation given at the start of the visit.

The welcome at the castle is warm, and the visit is fascinating. You will appreciate the patience of the guide, as well as the quality of the information provided.

It is forbidden to take photos inside the castle.
